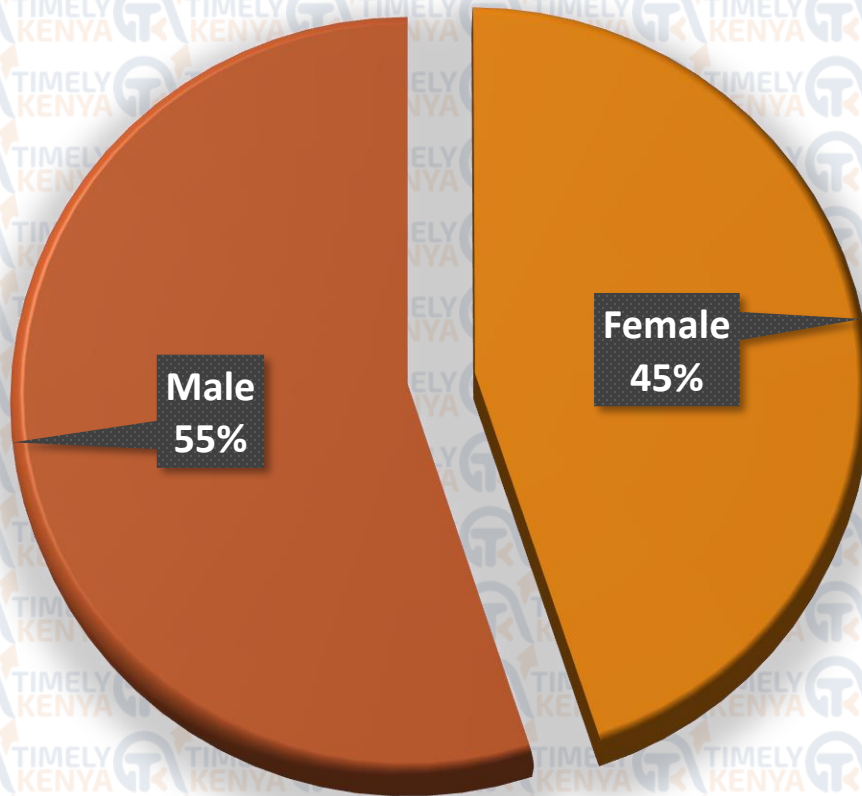

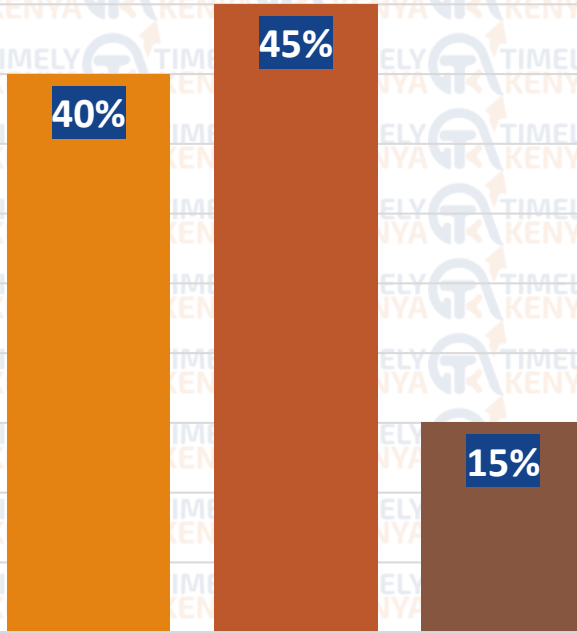

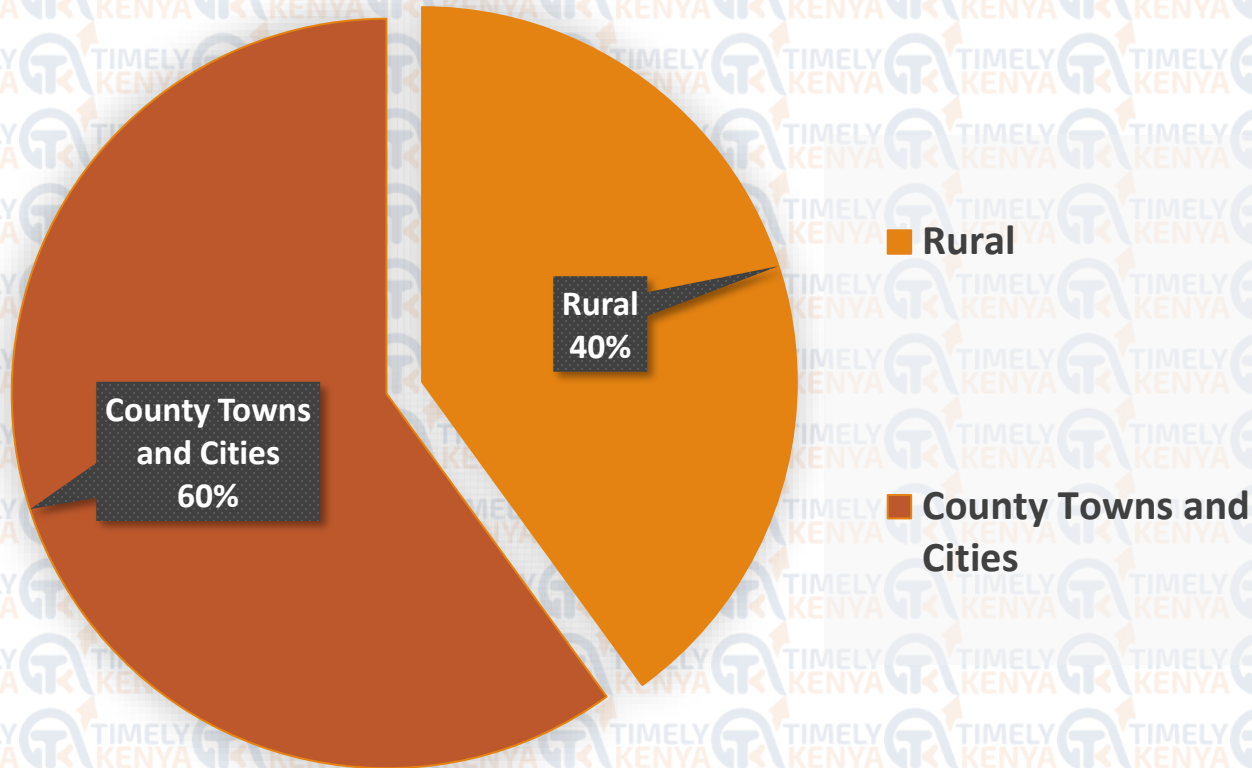

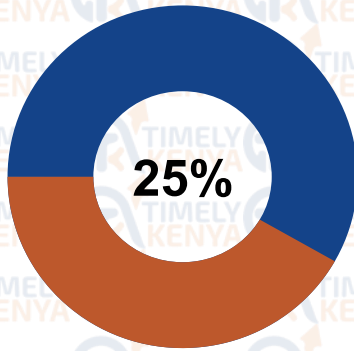

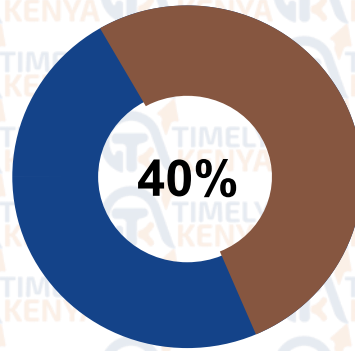
Settlement Demographics



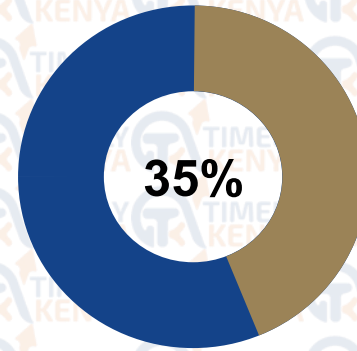
Level of Education Demographics

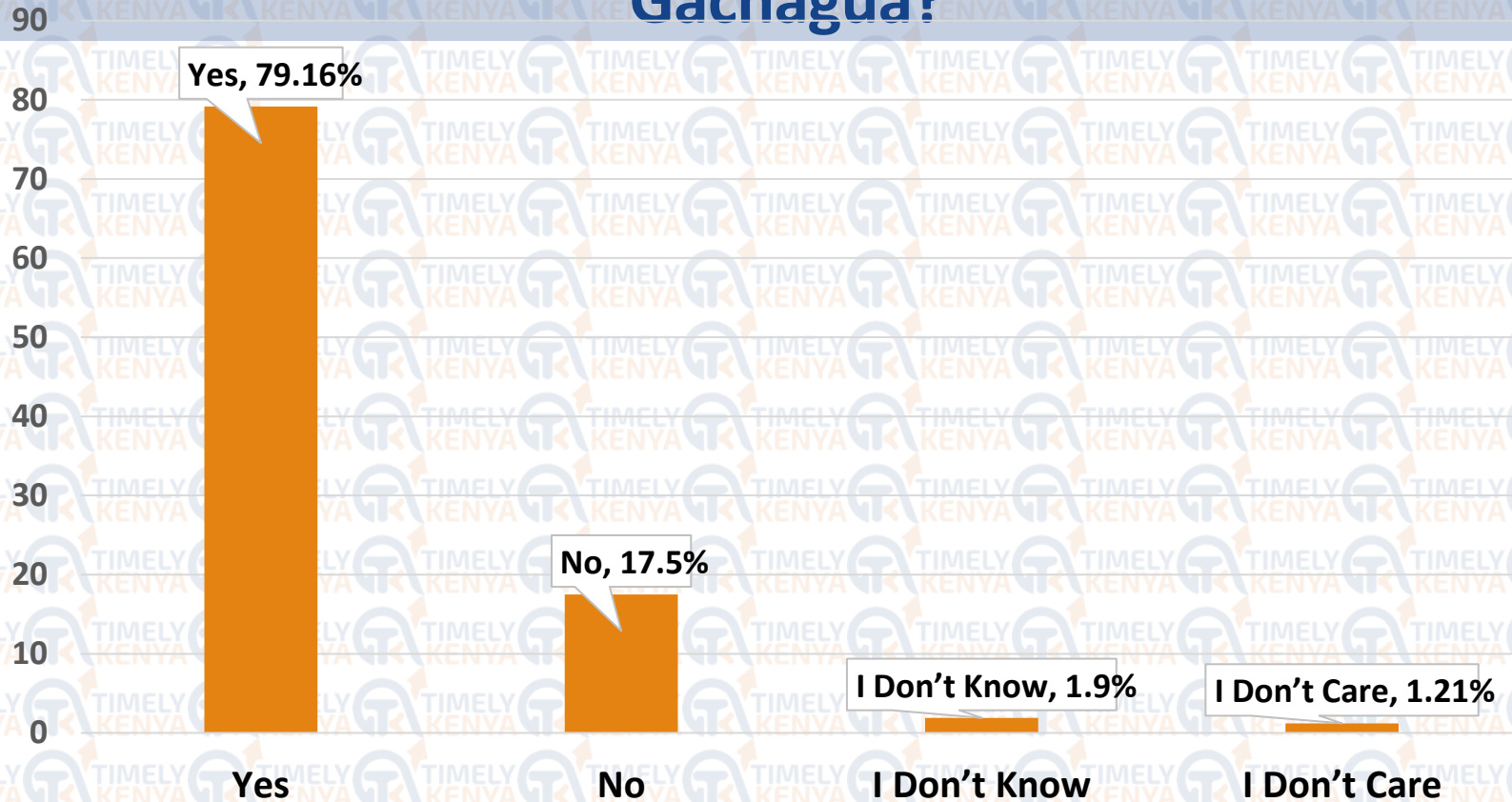

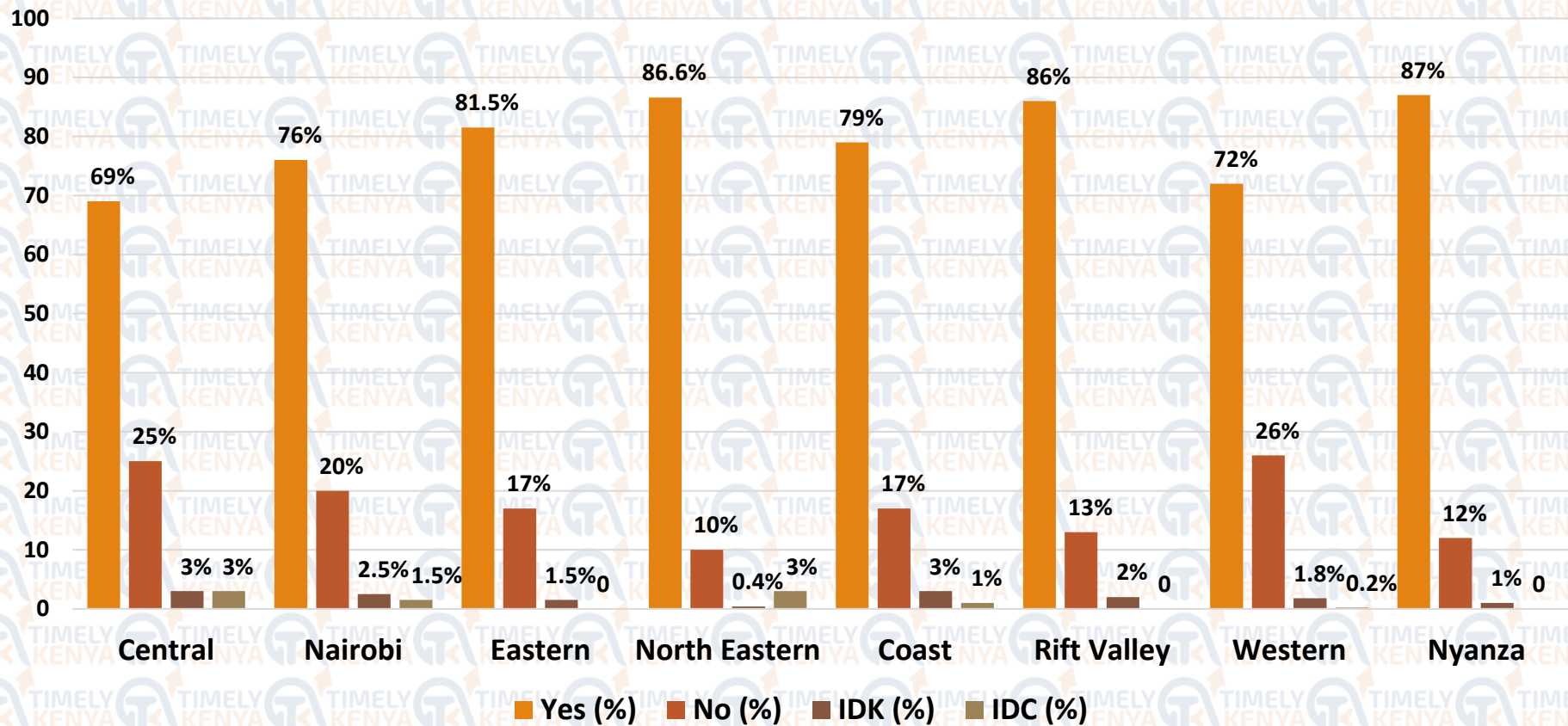

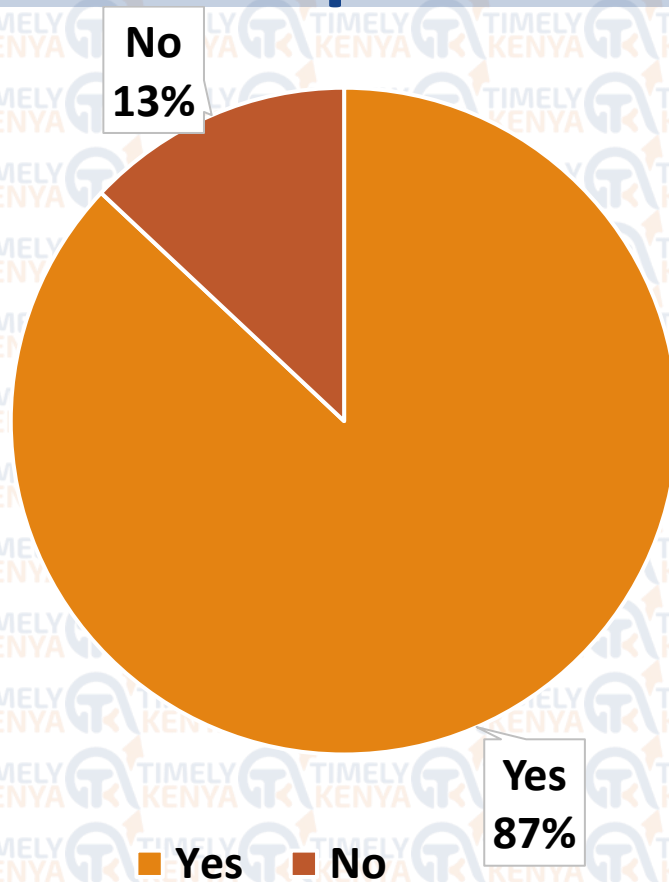

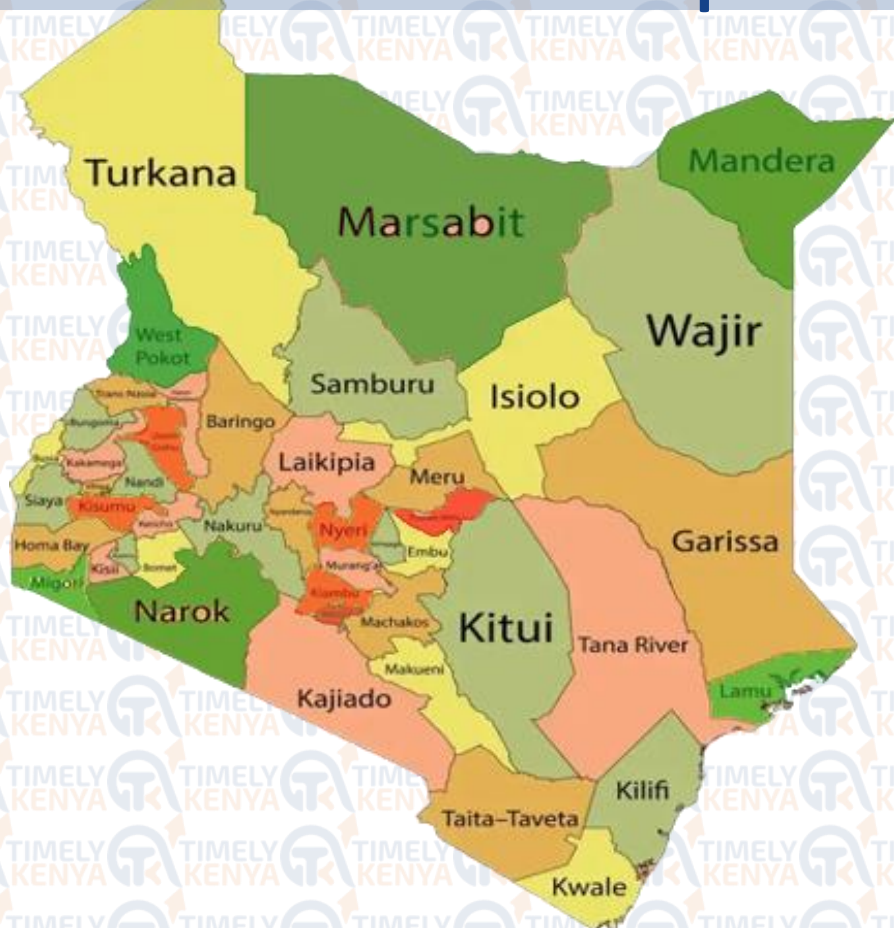
Distribution by Region

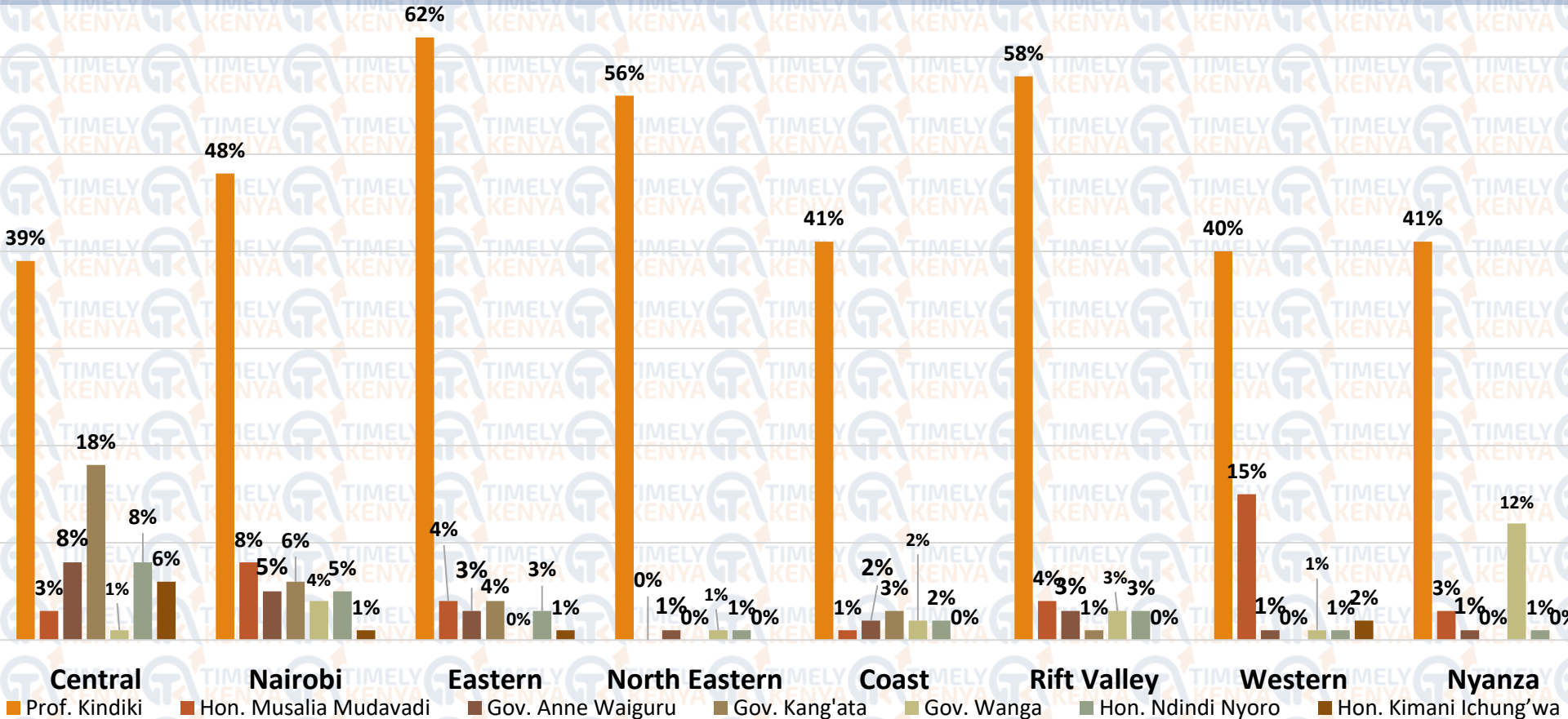

 Prof. Kithure Kindiki	- Amiable, non-tribal, results-oriented.	- Comes from a minority community.
	- Excellent track record in public service.	
	- Committed to service delivery; has never left the country since assuming office.	
 Ndindi Nyoro	- Youthful appeal.	- Lacks extensive experience in governance.
	- Knowledgeable on economic matters.	
 Musalia Mudavadi	- Moderate, non-adversarial, and diplomatic.	- Easily swayed and lacks conviction.
	- Extensive experience in governance.	- Seen as a regional kingpin, limiting national appeal.
 Anne Waiguru	- President Ruto's promise to have a female deputy may benefit her.	- NYS corruption allegations.
	- Strong administration and governance skills.	- Limited national political influence.
		- Perceived as combative and authoritarian.

General Observations

1. Majority believe DP Gachagua will be impeached.

2. Kithure Kindiki is the preferred replacement.

3. High regional awareness, but disparities across counties.
