A smaller but notable portion of respondents are based in county towns and urban centers, offering valuable input from more developed and infrastructure-rich settings.




70% Rural Areas

A majority of respondents reside in rural areas. This suggests that rural perspectives and experiences play a major role in shaping the overall insights.




Age Distribution






Educational Level




